Pope Francis asks us to "contemplate God's mercy and adopt it as our own lifestyle," by meditating on the Word of God. To do that, get in the habit of *Lectio Divina* (Latin for "divine reading") to pray with the Sunday's Scriptures weekly and/or pray with the daily readings every day.
